Continuing the Legacy of Addressing Deafness in Ghana

SOMERSET, NEW JERSEY – December 4, 2019 – Wilson Associates, LLC, and the [dfree® Global Foundation](#) announced today a collaboration with the Kibi School for the Deaf, in Kyebi, Eastern Region, Ghana. This collaboration will allow Wilson Associates to provide ongoing support and supplies for their infirmary.



Ali K. Wilson, J.D., Founder of Wilson Associates, stated, “This is a long-term and dedicated commitment to the Kibi School. We will dedicate a percentage of our earnings to help make a difference for those who are deaf in Kyebi. This collaboration comes at a time when the Kibi School for the Deaf, established some 40 years ago, is building an infirmary for its students.”

“On average, the 200-plus children in this institution live on less than a dollar a day, by funds allocated by the government to the cover cost of all expenses including room and board, medical needs, learning aids, and all other miscellaneous expenses,” said dfree® Ghana Coordinator Angela Dadson. “dfree® seeks to raise funds to support KSD with a subsidy of

\$2,000 a month for the next 12 months. This would afford an additional \$10 per child each month and would make a difference in their standard of living.

“We’re so happy for this partnership. I have been following Wilson Associates for some time now and to watch them grow over these years is exciting and now to see them give back, which is an essential part of the dfree® movement, is amazing. There is no greater and worthy project for them to get involved in than helping to sustain the Kibi School for the future,” said Dr. DeForest B. Every year, dfree® sponsors a trip to Ghana. The organization has committed to the development of Kyebi, in which it has contributed to the construction of the infirmary at the Kibi School of the Deaf. This year, dfree® also helped to establish a children’s library in Kyebi.

Kibi School for the Deaf currently has 250 deaf and mute children, 24 teachers, 26 non-teaching staff and caters for children from five years to 20 years. Quite often these children are overlooked by their families, distressed and alone in their communities.
